II. Chair's Opening Remarks

Chair Harris spoke about the FY17 budget, informing members that the School Committee is required to approve the FY17 budget by March 17, 2016, 45 days before the first Annual Town Meeting. Due to this deadline, a special meeting of the School Committee has been posted for Wednesday, March 16, 2017, which will be held if the School Committee does not vote approval of the FY17 budget at this meeting.

Chair Harris asked if any members would have objection to altering the order of the agenda and addressing agenda item VIII.F.1, consideration of proposed amendments to the Regional Agreement, immediately after the Committee addresses the FY17 budget, due to the need to provide the Member Towns with these proposed amendments for inclusion on Annual Town Meeting warrants. No members objected to this request.

III. Student Representatives' Reports (Linnea Budd, Liam Fritsche)

Student Representative Budd reported on WRHS DECA students moving on to nationals, and she also reported the regional science fair, which WRHS students will be participating, will be held on March 11th at WPI. Superintendent McCall explained the \$305,000 increase to the proposed FY17 budget made since the February 22, 2016 School Committee meeting.

At Chair Harris' invitation, Business/Finance Subcommittee Chair Jackson reported on the March 7, 2016 meeting of the Business/Finance Subcommittee. Subcommittee Chair Jackson reported the Business/Finance Subcommittee had voted to recommend full School Committee approval of a FY17 budget of \$85,500,000. Subcommittee Chair Jackson reported the Business/Finance Subcommittee vote was not unanimous. The roll call vote by the Business/Finance Subcommittee was 4-2.

IV. B. Discussion of Report

At Member Mills' inquiry, Superintendent McCall spoke about the search for the next principal of Mayo Elementary School. He informed the School Committee that final interviews of three candidates would be held at Mayo Elementary School on March 15, 2016, beginning at 4:00 PM.

Director Scanlon approached the podium to answer a question raised by Member Mills about OPEB, reported in Director Scanlon's report.

Member Dennis asked the status of the Holden Pupil Populations Study Task Force. Superintendent McCall reported this Task Force last met in September 2015, and at that meeting it was decided the next meeting would be scheduled after full-day kindergarten enrollment numbers were known. Discussion about this Task Force's charge and what additional needs to be addressed ensued. Superintendent McCall reported that, at this time, a decision about re-districting Holden school boundaries will not be brought forward, and that he plans to keep the Holden Pupil Population Task Force in place. Some additional discussion took place.

Member Novak expressed his disappointment with the details provided to the School Committee about the FY17 budget proposal in advance of the Committee's vote at this meeting. Member Novak requested copies of the textbook inventory, a listing of maintenance projects, and he asked that there be a more detailed discussion about the 2016-2021 Technology Plan

Member Porter spoke about the current principal search and referenced the search for three principals in the spring of 2015. There was some discussion about applicants interested in being employed by WRSD.
