POLICY RELATING TO PUPIL SERVICES

ENTRANCE AGE POLICY

The Wachusett Regional School District shall require that, in order to improve the prospect of school success and to allow a child to enter each grade at a time most appropriate to his or her readiness, the following be adhered to:

- 1. Any child entering kindergarten shall have attained the age of five (5) years on or before August 31st.
- 2. Any child entering first grade shall have attained the age of six (6) years on or before August 31st.

The parent seeking entrance of a child to first grade who does not meet the age requirement but who has completed an accredited kindergarten program in a public or private school, and whose records indicate that the child is ready for first grade, may be allowed to enter first grade at the discretion of the principal.
