By consensus, the Committee authorized the Superintendent to use similar parameters in negotiations with the cafeteria workers as with the aides. The Superintendent reminded the Committee that any increase negotiated with the food service workers would impact the cost of the school lunch program as the school lunch program is self-sufficient.

By consensus the Committee authorized the Superintendent to negotiate a salary increase similar to that negotiated in 1998, which was a 2.5% cost of living and 2.5% performance pool and to have the flexibility to offer 3.5% cost of living and 1.5% performance.
